REPORT

on the performed test
according to the method of “the vegetative resonant test”

Minsk, Belorussia

November 1, 2002

Within the period of 16.10.2002-30.10.2002, the specialists of BSU Republic Center of Human Issues carried out an investigation related with the effect imposed by the PC radiation onto human organism, as well as with the possibilities of its neutralization by application of the protective device Neitronik.

The investigation was performed in accordance with the method of “the vegetative resonant test” with hardware-and-software complex IMEDIS. (Certificate # 39/23-506-94 issued by Committee for New Medical Equipment of the RF; Certificate of Compliance # ROSS RU IMO 2.VO 2009 issued by State Committee for the Russian Federation for Standardization and Metrology. Date of Registry in the State Register – 10.01.1996.)

The tests were performed by Birilo I. G., a practitioner for bioresonance therapy of the Republican Center for Human Issues, on 4 PC operators before Neitronik installation and 14 day after it.

The initial test revealed existence of electromagnetic stress of the 2nd grade and negative influence of the electromagnetic fields been effected to 3 PC operators. Meanwhile during the final test, the electromagnetic stress and exposure of electromagnetic field could not be indicated in accordance with the method of “the vegetative resonant test”.

CONCLUSION. The performed tests showed that Neitronik application prevents electromagnetic stress effect on PC operators and mitigates the influence of electromagnetic field on them.
